1. ALPE-ADRIA UHF/SHF

DATE AND TIME:

Sunday in the third full weekend in June from 07.00 – 15.00 UTC

BAND AND MODES

Band: 432 MHz &up Modes: A1

(CW), SSB (J3E)

SECTIONS

Section A: only 70cm (432MHZ) Section B: only 23 cm (1.2 GHZ)

Section C: only 13 cm (2,3GHZ) and 5cm (5.7 GHZ)

Section D: only 3 cm (10 GHZ & up)

Remarks: No subdivision will be between single and multi-operators or fixed and portable stations in any section. One station can take part to more sections.

MULTIPLIERS:

70 cm : x 1 (1 point/km)
23 cm : x 1 (1 point/km)
13 cm : x 1 (1 point/km)
5 cm : x 3 (3 points/km)
3 cm : x 1 (1 point/km)
1.5cm : x 3 (3 point/km)
upper bands : x10 (10 points/km)
