It is the fourth time when the members of OL7M contest team went to MS dxp and this year wevisited rare squares in northeastern Poland and southwest Latvia.

During this trip we run over 2100km bytwo cars. We started QRV 2 days as SP/OK1MU fromKO13NX square. There were made on 144 MHz 102 MS+ 3 EME QSOs and on 50 MHz 51 Es QSOs. Than we moved exactly few meters to KO14NA as SP/OK1CID for just short 14 hours QRV and made others 50 MS QSO. Subsequently, we moved from Poland to Lithuania to our main objective square from this year, which was KO23BX. For the nex 3 days we loged 213 MS + 6 EME QSO under LY/OK2ZAW and LY/OK1CU call.

Totaly made on 144 MHz 365 MS QSO and 9 EME QSO with the only 11 el. YAGI and 450W PA, TRX IC-746PRO.




